“Shell Partners with WIEN on Learning, Mentorship Scheme”

Shell has entered into a collaboration with the Women In Energy Network (WIEN), to provide broader learning platforms for female professionals in the sector.

The collaboration would see greater participation of Shell in the activities of WIEN. Shell comes to table with global industry experience to prime up the skills and experience of the group’s members. It would on the other hand rely on WIEN for full-loop industry practice outlook that transcends the Shell way.

President of WIEN, Mrs Eyono Fatai-Williams, who led a delegation from the group to Shell Nigeria Exploration and Production Company (SNEPCO) Limited on the 11th of June 2024, stated that whereas WIEN commits to providing a learning platform that presents full-loop industry experience to its members in Shell, it looks forward to harnessing learning and mentorship resources available in Shell’s internal capacity building schemes.

Mrs. Fatai-Williams informed the delegation’s hosts headed by the Managing Director of SNEPCO, Mrs. Elohor Aiboni, that WIEN has a record of over 2000 hours of active learning as part of its focus on capacity building geared towards priming female professionals for full industry opportunities.

WIEN, she stated, holds a strong ambition for closing glaring gender gaps in the energy industry through a well thought out agenda supported by solid structures established by its Board of Trustees and Board of Directors respectively to prepare women for every role.



By placing a significant number of school girls on its scholarship programme and bringing experienced mentors onto the same platform with upcoming mentees, according to her, WIEN is building a pool of expertise that would provide the industry with sustainable skills.

“Energizing Nigeria”, ABC in Partnership with WIEN, NNPC & Exxon Mobil”

Energizing Nigeria, an Economic Update event, hosted by the American Business Council (ABC) in partnership with Women In Energy Network (WIEN), and sponsored by NNPC and Exxon Mobil was a breakfast event hosted on the 13th of July 2024.

This breakfast event featured energy industry experts who noted that gas flaring is a major source of greenhouse gases, contributing to global warming which could accelerate climatic change and worsen living conditions if not addressed. "Gas flaring, releases carbon dioxide and methane, the two major greenhouse gasses". Speakers called on the Nigerian government to expedite actions to eliminate gas flaring.

According to a World Bank report, gas flaring cost the global economy \$20 billion in 2018, with Nigeria losing N233 billion (\$761.6 million), accounting for 3.8% of the global total cost that year. Although the percentage of gas flared in Nigeria has been decreasing since 2002, standing at 10% in 2018, the country remains among the top 10 gas flaring nations, with 7.4 billion cubic feet flared in 2018. 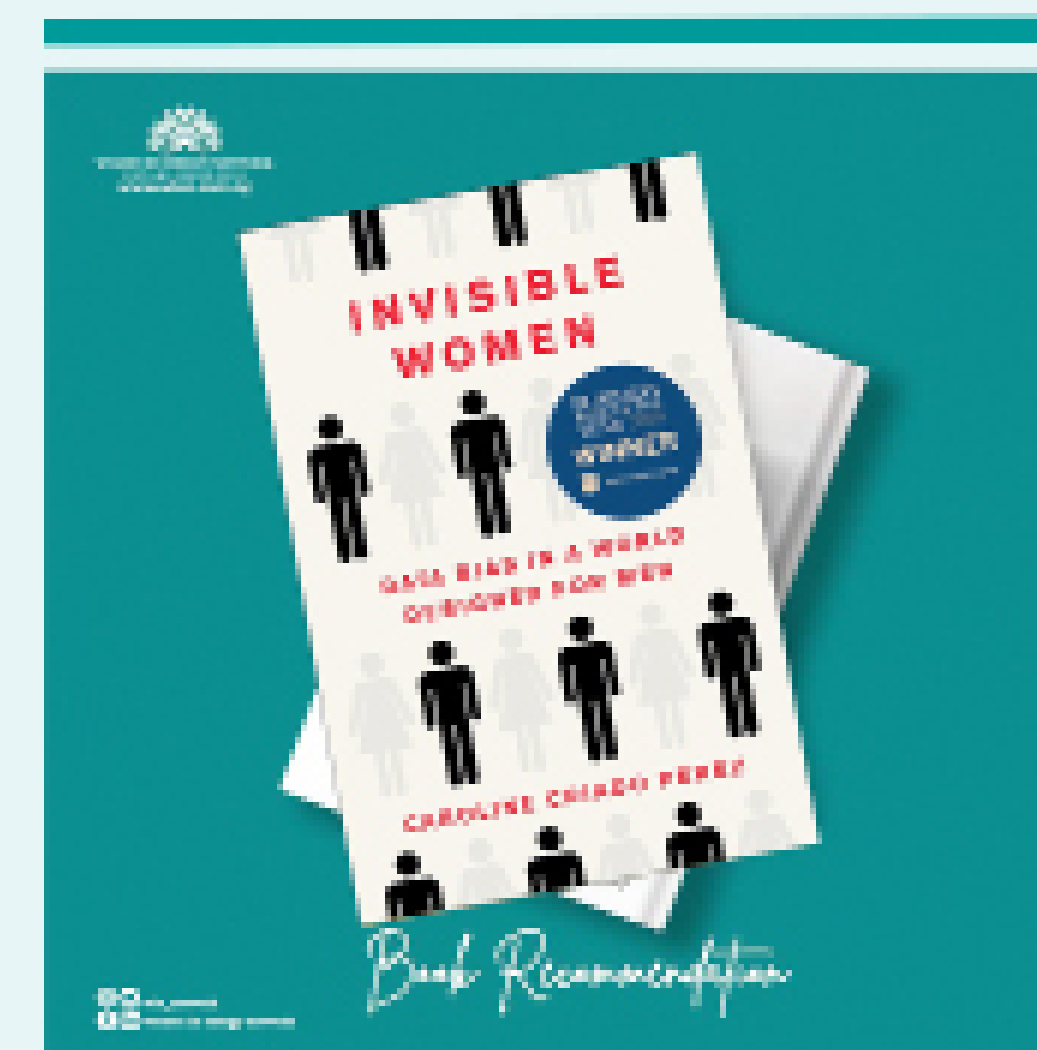
