"Women are Central to Africa's Energy Future"

At the 2026 Sub-Saharan Africa International Petroleum Exhibition and Conference (SAIPEC) in Lagos, the message was clear: Africa cannot import its future workforce. Speaking during the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) session, WIEN President Mrs. Eyono Fatai-Williams delivered a compelling keynote, challenging industry leaders to move beyond "goodwill" and toward radical accountability. For WIEN, gender equity isn't just a social goal—it is a strategic necessity for a stable, productive, and innovative energy sector.

People Before Technology

While the global conversation often focuses on digital tools and automation, Mrs. Fatai-Williams reminded the audience that technology is only as effective as the humans who design, maintain, and operate it.

To be "future-ready," the African energy workforce must be:

Digitally Literate: Comfortable with data and automation.

Multidisciplinary: Able to pivot between oil, gas, renewables, and emerging power solutions.



Homegrown: Built locally, deliberately, and inclusively.

"Workforce gaps left unaddressed today will become operational risks tomorrow, affecting safety, productivity, and long-term competitiveness."

Closing the "System Design" Failure






